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The Quran was written down by select scribes in the time of the Prophet Muhammad and memorized and recited five times in daily prayers.

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




The Quran is not organized by subject matter or in chronological order and its power lies in recitation and listening to it in Arabic.

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The longest chapter of the Quran has 286 verses, the shortest has 3.

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The Quran has 114 chapters and 114 times the Quran says 'In the Name of God, the Most Merciful, the Compassionate'.

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




Translations of Quran are just that. The Quran is only in Arabic as it was revealed; no other scripture is like that.

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The Quran emphasizes the kind treatment of women, poor, slaves, and orphans.

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The Quran paints the picture of the end of the world in graphic detail.

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The Quran frequently talks about God's coming judgment so we can live responsibly.

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The Quran has stories of past prophets, prophecies of the future, and the working of God in the present all tied to God's power.

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The Quran stresses God's judgment and forgiveness, God's justice and mercy, God's might and forbearance all at the same time.

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Focus of the Quran: serve and worship God in all you do, in how you live, and how you interact with people and your environment.

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Make Quran your friend for life - not just for 1 month.

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
