
Rights of WOMEN in Islam

Marriage in Islam: what hers is hers and what's yours is hers! Tell me, how can you say that Islam gives no rights?








Everyday is Mother's Day for a Muslim.

When you see women wearing the veil in the West, they are not being oppressed; it is always their choice!








Funny how Muslim women are 'oppressed '! Estimated 80% new converts to Islam are women!
